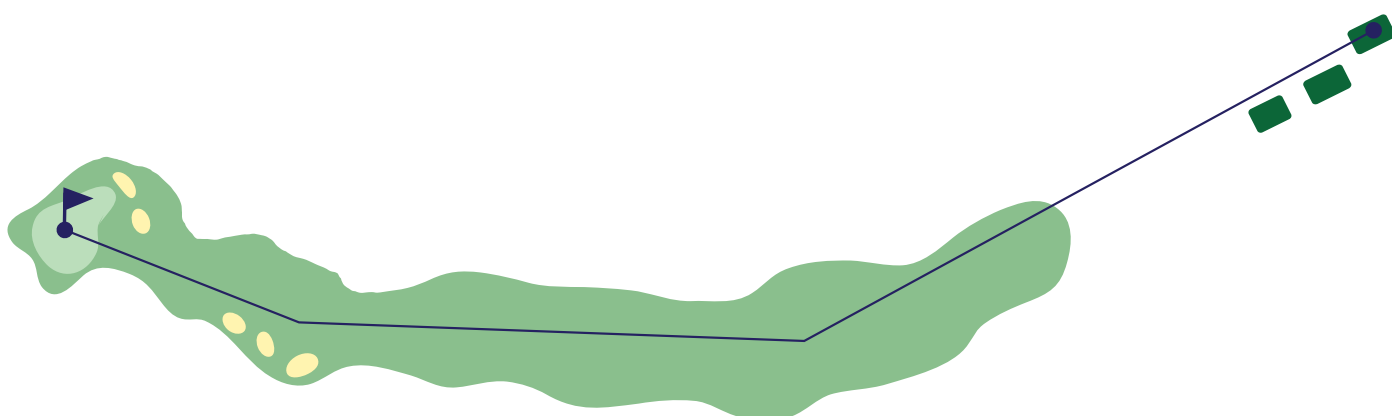




Hole 6

A large Beech tree needs to be carried, bunkers are down the left side of the fairway and go too far right and you will have a difficult third shot - over some deep bunkers.
